## Executive Summary

STC is determined to prepare students well who pursue baccalaureate degrees and to facilitate their successful transfer to institutions granting such degrees.

- ✓ Of the 784 Academic Majors that graduated in academic year 2005-2006, 63% transferred to UTPA,.
- ✓ Students transferring from STC to UTPA in Fall 2006 earned, on average, a term GPA of 2.62, as compared with an overall term undergraduate GPA of 2.52 for all UTPA students.

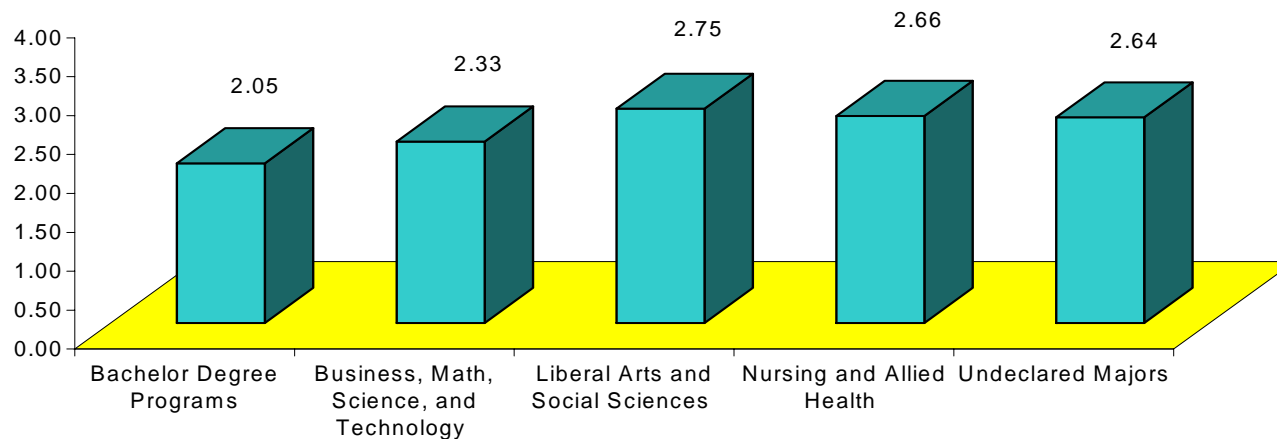
